The Heritage Interpreter/Guide is one of three such summer student positions that greet visitors to the Jean Pierre Roma National Historic Site (NHS) at 505 Roma Point Rd, Brudenell, PEI.

Students fluent in both English and French, completing Grade 10 or 11, or enrolled in post-secondary training are preferred candidates for these positions.

Work term and pay rate:

Job Duties

Welcome visitors in English and/or French to Roma at the Three Rivers National Historic Site with a brief history about the Jean Pierre Roma French settlement of the 1730s.

Perform interpretive duties as part of the Roma summer program. These will include themed interpretation, outdoor guided tours and leading authentic activities on a daily basis; participate in serving and interpreting the heritage lunches on a daily basis; participate as a costumed server in serving and interpreting 1730s heritage meals with 1730s style tableware, food and customs.

Assist site manager and Board of Directors in all revenue generation activities on site and, on occasion, off site.

Take part in training programs conducted by volunteers and supervisor; assist in compilation of background material and information relevant to Jean Pierre Roma NHS.

Contribute to program evaluation by various means including on-site observation, visitor surveys, and recording visitor comments.

Wear a 1700s period costume provided by Roma at Three Rivers

Be willing to learn and practice new skills that are related to the settlement history

Be willing to work, days, week-end, evenings and holidays on a rotation schedule

Be available for the full duration of employment.

To have some experience in dealing with the public, preferably in heritage interpretation, or in tourism

To be physically able to conduct outdoor presentations and tours of the NHS and nature trails.
